Nature Enlightened

During the month of January

The Royal Alcázar presents *Dreams*, a light show inspired by King Philip V's stay in Seville. Palace gardens are transformed into a magical setting, creating an immersive experience in a unique scenario, declared a World Heritage Site.

Ceramics Museum

At Triana District

Discover Seville's rich pottery tradition at the Triana Ceramics Museum. Located in a former ceramics factory, it showcases the evolution of Sevillian ceramic art over the centuries, featuring historic pieces and unique techniques. Explore an essential part of the local culture.

Palacio de Dueñas

Historic Palace House guided tour

This is one of the 25 Palace Houses of Seville. Built in the 15th century, it was property of the Duchy of Alba since the 17th century, the residence of the Spanish poet Antonio Machado and witness to illustrious guests of the Dukes of Alba such as Jacqueline Kennedy, Grace Kelly or Rainier of Monaco. Discover the palace, patios and gardens.



Palacio de la Condesa de Lebrija

Cultural Interest Site and Historical Heritage of Spain

Located on Cuna Street, this is a unique museum considered “the best paved palace in Europe”, which stands out for its collection of Roman mosaics (especially those covering the central courtyard), as well as archaeological pieces and Renaissance architecture. It was restored by the Countess (illustrious lady and archeology lover) in 1901 to display her collection of antiquities.

Córdoba

Day trip

Famous for its Mosque-Cathedral, Córdoba is a peaceful and charming winter destination. Its historic center -a UNESCO World Heritage Site- feels magical with decorated patios, cobbled streets, local markets and cozy taverns offering traditional dishes. January is the perfect time to enjoy Córdoba’s culture and history at a relaxed, easygoing pace.
